<b>11. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:</b>	All internal courses will have 100% component as internal evaluation at the institute level. All external courses will have 60% internal component and 40% component as external [University] examination  <b>All courses have 100 % internal evaluation.</b>	
<b>12. STANDARD OF PASSING:</b>	The assessment of the students for each examination is done, based on relative performance. Maximum Grade Point (GP) is 10 corresponding to O (Outstanding). For all courses, a student is required to pass both internal and external examination separately with a minimum Grade Point of 4 corresponding to grade P. Students securing less than 40% absolute marks in each head of passing will be declared FAIL. The University awards a degree to student who has achieved a minimum CGPA of 4 out of maximum.	
<b>13. AWARD OF DEGREE :</b>	Certificate in Image processing: Digital and film will be awarded at the end of external examination by taking into consideration the performance of all the semester examinations after obtaining minimum 4.00 CGPA out of 10 CGPA.
